C-1 Brother Is A Verb: Religious Brothers in the United States

Tape kit contains video and leader manual. The tape is effective for general adult education, parish and continuing education setting and by university/secondary students in class gatherings. The leader manual has discussion questions for small or large groups. **\$40**

C-2 Men Vowed and Sexual: Conversations About Celibate Chastity

Six half-hour video segments, articles that deal with various aspects of chastity, reflection questions, and feature-length film resources. Aims to start conversation about celibate chastity and the spiritual question, On whom or what do I set my heart? **\$75**

C-3 Shadow on the Family: AIDS in Religious Life

Video documentary intended for audiences involved with the presence of AIDS within the Catholic priesthood and brotherhood of the United States. Interview footage from nine participants includes one brother's story, theological context, confidentiality, going public, telling the community, and legal concerns.
